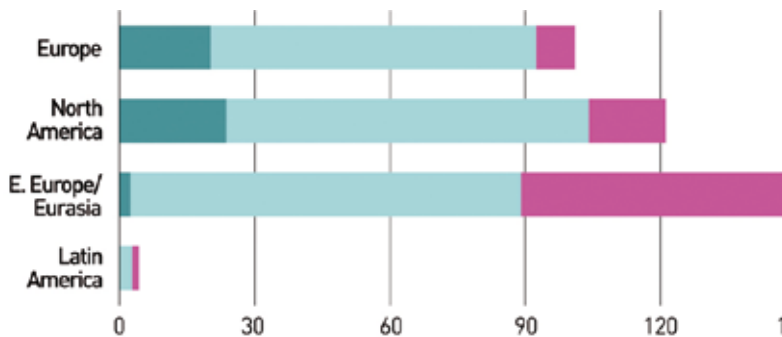
NUCLEAR CLEAN-UP

AMEC is major contractor in clean-up and in managing the operations of major UK nuclear facilities as a long-term partner to the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA).

- We are part of the Nuclear Management Partners consortium, along with URS Washington Division and AREVA - which owns Sellafield Ltd and manages Sellafield Sites
- As part of an Alliance with UKAEA and CH2M Hill we have imbedded support on the Dounreay site in Scotland to decommission the site
- We have a long track record in the delivery of Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contracts at Sellafield and Dounreay
- We are the project manager for the Ignalina reactor decommissioning in Lithuania, one of the largest decommissioning projects in Europe
- AMEC and the UKAEA have a Memorandum of Understanding with the Korean Power Engineering Company (KOPEC) targeting nuclear waste management and repository projects and decommissioning as well as other services.
- In 2008 we acquired the Slovak specialist nuclear services company AllDeco, s.r.o.
- We operate the NIRAS laboratory, which provides independent radioactivity testing from waste characterisation supporting nuclear decommissioning through to environmental monitoring
